TICKET ALLOCATION GUIDELINES

Due to unreasonable demands and expectations of a few Club members the following guidelines will be referred to when allocating tickets especially in times when demand is greater than supply.

Tickets will only in the first instance be available to Full members of Owen Roe O'Neill's GAC, Leckpatrick. (This includes Youth, Family, Student and Senior Citizen members where the appropriate fees have been paid).

Preference in ticket allocation will be given to those who have paid their current Full or Youth membership fees by 31st March that year and who are active members of the Club.

Payment of membership fees cannot be taken as a guarantee of acquiring tickets.

Social members are not in the first instance entitled to tickets. They may be considered for tickets later but only when supply is greater than demand.

When there is a higher demand for match tickets than the number of tickets allocated, they will be allocated in accordance with the criteria laid down by the Committee - this would see preference given to active Club officials, workers, adult players and youth players.

A sub-committee consisting of the Chairperson, the Secretary and the Treasurer (or their assistants or another delegated Committee member) will be responsible for the allocation in accordance with the agreed guidelines at such times.

Tickets are allocated for the benefit of Full Club members and their immediate family and should not be sought for non-members when demand is high.

At no time should tickets be sold for profit and Club members are reminded that ticket allocations are for the use of the Club and its members. Infringements of these regulations will be dealt with by the Club Committee.

The number of tickets per member will depend upon the number of tickets available and the extent of the demand. In general Full adult members should not expect an allocation of more than 2 tickets, and, subject to availability, Youth members may be entitled to 1 ticket each.

Requests for tickets should be made to the Club Secretary or other designated Official before the County distribution takes place. Late requests will only be taken if the number of tickets exceeds demand.

Tickets for games not involving Tyrone must be ordered with the Club Secretary at least 10 days beforehand. Members should specify at the time of ordering the particular seating requirements and location they would prefer but the allocation will be at the discretion of the Club Committee.

Family tickets, and tickets for the disabled and O.A.P.'s, are now available for most matches and if you wish to avail of these please say so when ordering.

Tickets will be distributed on a designated night and all tickets ordered should be collected and paid for on that night.

Tickets not collected will be reallocated by the Committee in charge except where special arrangements have been made. At this stage the committee in charge may take into account the requests for additional tickets by Club members and non-members who can show a level of commitment to the ideals of the G.A.A.

If tickets are cancelled after they have been ordered from the County Board, it is that member's responsibility to pay for these tickets. Non-payment for these tickets will see sanctions imposed on future ticket requests. The Club accepts no responsibility for the resale of tickets cancelled.
