LEAS CATHAOIRLEACH/VICE-CHAIR

- Stands in for the Chair when necessary
- Plays a prominent role in the Club
- Usually chairs an important Sub-Committee
- Is usually seen as the Chair-in-waiting
- Contributes at County level as appropriate

The post of Vice-Chairperson should be regarded as a training post of a future Cathaoirleach.

The Vice-Chairperson should be given specific duties apart from the obvious one of taking the place of an absent Cathaoirleach, such as being nominated Cathaoirleach of a Sub-Committee or taking responsibility for assisting the Chairperson in developing links with other local community groups.
